## KINGFISHER GLAZING FRAMES

- Kingfisher glazing frames are supplied as fully assembled units designed to be installed within pre-prepared rebates on site by others.
- The glazing depth should be specified at point of order; typically, standard sizes are 24mm or 28mm. For other depths please contact Kingfisher's Technical Sales team who can advise.
- The rebates for installation can vary but typically would be a minimum of 20mm. The leg of the glazing louvre is typically either 38mm or 41mm.
- The louvre must be held within the rebate using a suitable glazing material (supplied by others) to provide a weatherproof seal to the edge of the frame and into the glazing rebate.
- If required, once within the glazing rebate, further sealant can be used at the face or rear of the louvre to finish the edges where the product sits within the rebate.
- No mechanical fixings are supplied with the glazing frames and so the glazing compound must be suitable to fix the weight of the louvres supplied. Weights available on request.
